

Stationery and textbook requirements for High School

The school will give you exercise books (feint/margin, quad and graph), A5 hardcover manuscript books (as necessary for a subject) and A4 exam pads at the beginning of the school year and when you need it throughout the year (go and see your subject teacher when you run out).

You will need to have the following:

- A Navy Blue School Bag
- Calculator basic four function up to and including Year 8.
 Scientific calculator for Year 9 and above
- Mathematical instrument set
- A flash drive / memory stick
- Pencil bag or case and:
 - 1 x 30cm ruler (normal width) Black or blue ballpoint pen Black fineliner Pencil Pencil sharpener Highlighter Eraser Scissors Glue stick Sellotape Pencil crayons (Colleen or Aquarel) - standard Felt tipped pens (set of 10, medium point) - standard Flip file (10 page)

You need to buy your own files and A4 Pads (punched) beyond those supplied by the School and you should replace your stocks as needed throughout the year.

Textbooks are supplied by the School. The books are numbered and are issued to you by your subject teacher. You need to sign for the books you get as a record is kept by the School. At the end of the year, the books are taken in again, so you need to return the book with the number you signed for. If you lose a book or it is damaged (more than normal 'wear and tear'), you will need to replace it. The textbooks are usually very expensive, so look after them carefully.
