LEARNING AT HOME

Since term ended early on Tuesday, staff have been at school preparing for next term's eLearning and deep cleaning the building and grounds.

Lessons and resources will be sent from 1st April.

Year 3 will be using Class Dojo to share lesson materials. Years 4, 5 and 6 will use Google Classroom.

'Paper' tasks (like worksheets) can be printed off, or completed using a device. If you can't print, you can also follow instructions on-screen, but write answers on a piece of paper (clearly label which question or task is being worked on. And include your name!)

Any work completed on paper can be scanned/photographed and submitted electronically, or returned to school when we re-open.

Teachers will be available via Google Classroom/Class Dojo and email if you have any questions. Wherever possible, teachers will respond as soon as possible on 'school days' between 08:00-14:00. Do not expect an immediate response – response time will be affected by internet access, loadshedding, health, and their own family responsibility. Please be patient.
