

Year 3 Stationery List

In KS2, children use iPads (provided by the school) for educational purposes. Each Year 3 student must provide a set of **name-labelled, basic headphones**. These will stay in school for the year. Please store in a labelled zip-lock bag. We recommend wired 'over the head' headphones - please don't send in expensive headphones with additional features, or headphones that require charging.

Standard recorder (for Music lessons) - available from Music shops such as Paul Bothner.

In KS2 children each have their own personal stationery that stays in their locker/school bag or at school. All items must be clearly labelled. Everyday stationery should be in an easily accessible fabric pencil case.

Spare and less frequently used items should be kept in a labelled tub (such as ice cream container) that the class teacher will store. Otherwise, stationery can be replaced as necessary during the year. Please check your child's pencil case regularly.
