



Stationery requirements for High School 2020: Keystone 3

The school will provide exercise books (feint/margin, quad and graph), hardcover manuscript books at the beginning of the school year.

Bring the following on the first day of school:

- Calculator - basic four function up to and including Year 8.
- Scientific calculator for Year 9 and above
- Mathematical instrument set
- Pencil bag or case and:
 - 1 x 30cm ruler (normal width)
 - Black fineliner
 - Pencil sharpener
 - Eraser
 - Glue stick
 - Felt tipped pens (set of 10, medium point)
 - Black or blue ballpoint pens
 - Pencil
 - Highlighter
 - Scissors
 - Pencil crayons (Colleen or Aquarel)
- You will also need to buy a selection of files as stipulated below:
 - Select the correct Year Group row in the table.
 - Only buy the stationery specific to your child's subject choices and year of study.

Notebooks are supplied by the school. The school will provide one exam pad for each subject which requires these in Keystages 4 and 5. Additional exam pads (where needed) will be provided by parents.

Textbooks are supplied by the School. The books are numbered and are issued to you by your subject teacher. You need to sign for the books you get as a record is kept by the School. At the end of the year, the books are taken in again, so you need to return the book with the number you signed for. If you lose a book during the year or if it is damaged (more than normal 'wear and tear'), you will be charged the replacement cost. The textbooks are usually very expensive, so look after them carefully.
