

Apps/Websites for learning and assessment

Your child has been issued with usernames and passwords for Mathletics and Accelerated Reader. We ask the children to keep these details in their homework diary or make a note using their iPad.

Please ask the class teacher if your child can't find/remember their login details.

These two resources can be used on a computer or tablet, and are used by children to practise assigned Maths tasks and track their reading (Years 3-5). We are able to monitor the results of tasks/reading quizzes as part of our ongoing assessment of each child.

Mathletics: Free app

Mathletics tasks are assigned as weekly homework. Activities are designed to be repeated or revised in order to improve the score if necessary. Certificates can be earned for the tasks completed, and these are given out during Tuesday assemblies.

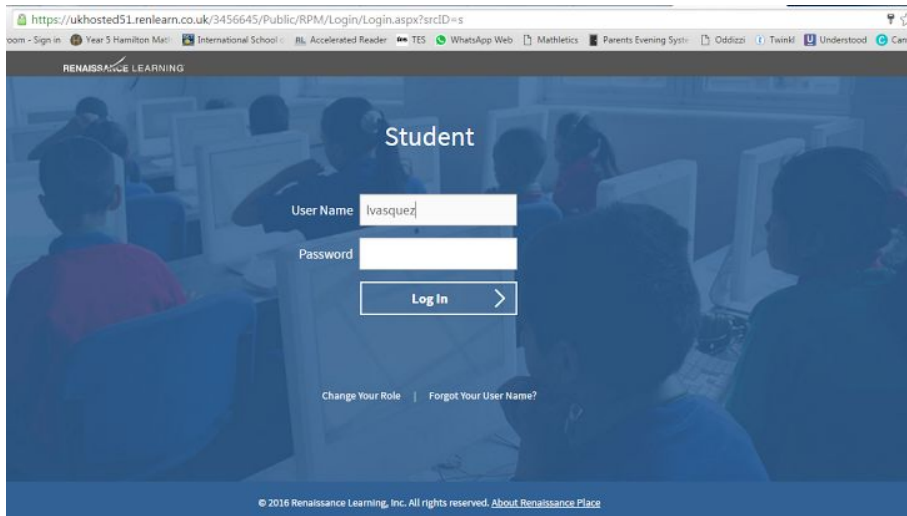

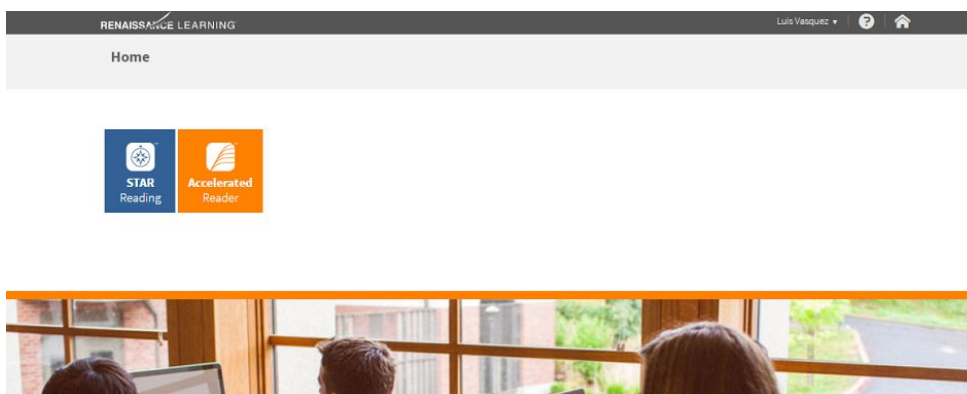
To login on the Accelerated Reader website, use QR Code or link above:

Please don't just search for 'Accelerated Reader' in your browser: You will not be able to log in to the ISCT site.

Children enter their username and password to enter the Student Site.



Then, select Accelerated Reader (orange).



Next, enter the name of the book title in the search bar ("Find a Book"). This will take you to the quiz.

Children must read the question carefully and *find the answer in the book* to choose the correct answer. **This must be done independently.**

Children will be able to see their results onscreen, and there is an option to check the incorrect answers to find the correct answer. **This part can be down with adult support.**

The class teacher monitors the quizzes from school and can see scores and progress. Targets are set based on the 'number' (level or grading) of the books,

percentage of correct answers, and number of books. Children can earn certificates that are awarded in assemblies.
