LESSON ATTENDANCE FROM HOME

Attendance of live register & live video lessons on your child's school day is expected.

Try not to be late joining the lesson – this is disruptive for the teacher and class, and children miss key information.

Ensure that your child has a quiet workspace. Headphones may be helpful.

GOOGLE CLASSROOM

Remember that there is work to be completed via Google Classroom on non-school days.

WORK MUST BE HANDED IN BY THE DUE DATE. Please help your child to <u>CHECK which work has not yet been</u> <u>completed.</u>

Work should be <u>attached to the correct assignment</u> in Google Classroom (even if it is a photo/scan of the work done on paper).

Ensure that you have been added as a guardian in Google Classroom in order to receive a weekly summary of your child's work.

Subjects taught by specialist/floating teachers have their own separate Google Classrooms. Please double check that your child has joined ALL of the relevant subject Classrooms.

The messages about stranger danger (and related dangers) can be sensitive and disturbing – best discussed at home rather than going into detail at school.
