Work should be <u>attached to the correct assignment</u> in Google Classroom (even if it is a photo/scan of the work done on paper).

Ensure that you have been added as a guardian in Google Classroom in order to receive a weekly summary of your child's work.

### ONLINE SAFFTY

This half term in Computing (ICT) we have focused on online safety and awareness.

The lesson resources are in your child's Computing Google Classroom. Please go through these lesson presentations with your child(ren) to reinforce the importance of being alert and careful when using the internet.

Children can play <u>Be Internet Awesome</u> – an online game to teach and practise being *Internet Smart, Alert, Strong, Kind* and *Brave*.

Parents: Please ensure that you keep up to date with the security and safety of your home internet and network, as well as information about what/how to have discussions at home about online safety. The messages about stranger danger (and related dangers) can be sensitive and disturbing – best discussed at home rather than going into detail at school.
