



Stationery requirements for High School 2021: Keystage 3

The school will provide exercise books (feint/margin, quad and graph) and hardcover manuscript books at the beginning of the school year.

Bring the following on the first day of school:

- Calculator - basic four function up to and including Year 8.
- Scientific calculator for Year 9 and above
- Mathematical instrument set
- Pencil bag or case
- Basic stationery:

1 x 30cm ruler (normal width)	Black or blue ballpoint pens
Black fineliner	HB Pencils
Pencil sharpener	Highlighters
Eraser	Scissors
Glue stick	Pencil crayons (Colleen or Aquarel)

The school will provide one exam pad for each subject which requires these. Additional exam pads (where needed) will be provided by parents.

Textbooks are supplied by the School. The books are numbered and are issued to you by your subject teacher. You need to sign for the books you get as a record is kept by the School. At the end of the year, the books are taken in again, so you need to return the book with the number you signed for. If you lose a book during the year or if it is damaged (more than normal 'wear and tear'), you will be charged the replacement cost. The textbooks are usually very expensive so they should be treated with care.
