# Extra-Curricular Activities

The responses from the recent survey indicates that the majority of parents are keen for a return to the 'normal' optional ECAs. Based on this feedback we have continued to make plans for optional sign-ups and private providers for Term 3. Sign-up for Term 3 ECAs will open next week, through a Google Form that will be shared via class reps and the newsletter. Activities will have limited numbers as we need to have space in indoor venues for all activities in the event of wet weather.

We hope that by mid-July when Term 3 starts we will be able to run the 'normal' ECA activities as we are planning. **However** this is dependent on government guidelines, particularly around the third wave that we have been anticipating this term. It may be necessary to continue with our current extended days (class enrichment activities) into Term 3.

The Department of Basic Education has suspended contact sports and interschool matches. This doesn't affect our current setup as we are able to continue with training and fitness sessions for our sporting enrichment activities for the next few weeks of Term 2.

# Reports

In the primary school we issue reports at the end of Term 2 and Term 4. Reports are published electronically through the Parent Portal and Edana Parent app.

We use the following terms to describe or grade a child's level of attainment:

For a child to be assessed as **working at the expected standard** they will need to have achieved and have evidence of being able to work consistently at all the Key Performance Indicators (learning objectives) for their year group. The term used to describe this attainment is **Secure**.

Based on parent feedback, we are working on making the reports more clearly show your child's level of attainment. You may notice minor changes in the reports this year.

Later in the year we'll have opportunities for more parent information and feedback (such as a survey or meeting) specifically around how we assess and report.

#### What you can expect in this term's report:

- ✓ Subject grading to indicate Emerging (E) or Developing (D) attainment in that subject area
- \* Reports **do not** include a percentage or grade based on test scores.
- ✓ The comment from the teacher will indicate your child's strengths as well as targets for the coming months. These targets may be areas to work on in order to *reach* the expected level, or to ensure that your child *continues* to progress at the expected level.
- Lists of Achieved and Target 'I can' statements have been removed returning to more detailed teacher comments.
- With the bigger picture of the whole year's learning objectives in mind, 'Developing' is the expected level mid-year.
- We don't write exams in KS2. Teachers assess children throughout the year based on lesson participation, work in books, projects/presentations, regular weekly tests, more formal assessment sittings, and verbal contributions such as questions or discussions with the teacher. This 'evidence' is used to make a judgement about their current attainment.
- Although we want reports to be friendly and positive, they are written to inform you as parents (and potentially for other educational institutions or external professionals). The tone and context of a report is not aimed at children. It is your choice as parents if you wish to show or read portions of the report to your child, but this is not its primary purpose.

## My child doesn't stay for enrichment activities on Tuesdays/Thursdays.

Please don't block the driveway system by waiting for later children. Park in the dustbowl or come at the later KS2 time. *Younger KS2 children will be supervised in the library if waiting for older KS2 siblings*.

#### There is a timing clash with Struben House for my younger child.

Running late for WH - Please let your class teacher know so we can arrange for KS2 children to wait in the library if you will be a few minutes late.

Arriving early at WH – Please don't park in the driveway system if you are earlier than your KS2 child's finish time. Use the outside parking area please.

#### I also need to fetch a child at High School finish time.

Please book your child into Aftercare if waiting for High School sibling.

Fridays only: HS siblings will be supervised on the loggia until 13:50.

Aftercare not necessary if you can pick up by 13:50.

- → Library supervision is only during the KS2 staggered finishing times to allow for a single KS2 pickup. If you will be later than ten minutes after KS2 finish times, please book your child into Aftercare.
- → KS2 children are not allowed to wait unsupervised or in the library for High School siblings.

If your child needs to wait later than our KS2 staggered finishing times please book your child into Aftercare. For a short wait within KS2 staggered finishing times, arrange with class teacher to wait in the library.

#### I can't get to Woodland Heights at my child's pickup time.

Please book your child into Aftercare if you know in advance that you cannot get to Woodland Heights within 10 minutes after your year group pickup time. If you're just running a little late for some reason on a particular day, please let Ms Funani know.
