

INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL OF CAPE TOWN: DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE & FRAMEWORK: UPDATED November 2021:

EXPECTATIONS ON STUDENTS: In general terms, Students should avoid any behaviour which could bring the school's reputation into disrepute

and observe the following:

- Comply with instructions and the general rules of the school;
- Behave responsibly and not endanger the safety and welfare of others
- Respect and care for the property of the School and others
- Maintain sound relations with others at School, be courteous and respect the dignity and self-worth of others and their property
- Be punctual and observe the timekeeping practices of the School
- Demonstrate a positive attitude towards the opportunity to learn, and be diligent in their efforts to learn
- Behave honestly and conduct themselves with integrity
- Accept legitimate punishment and disciplinary action taken against them as being both consequential and corrective.
- The School has a number of specific rules, which define the kinds of behaviour expected of its students; students are advised of these rules and expected to conduct themselves within the rules provided.
- It is impossible for this procedure to list every possible rule infringement and this guideline and the attached Code, therefore, we have set out the broad principles of fair discipline at the School. The Staff and Prefects are entitled to apply action that they believe is appropriate in the circumstances, within the guidelines provided by this procedure.

If a student engages in any behaviour that brings the school into disrepute, the school reserves the right to address this within this framework.

Any instances of bullying or peer on peer sexual harassment or abuse will be dealt with separately according to the Bullying Policy and Safeguarding and Child Protection Policy.

Disruptive behaviour (including disturbing the library) Missing a sports practice/match without permission Taking books out of the library without signing them out Insolence Poor sportsmanship Offensive or abusive language: Excluding the category 1 words Inappropriate displays of affection on the school property 	First Level 2 demerit is referred to management who will place the event on record. Parents are notified after the second Level 2 demerit and the student is suspended from lessons after the third Level 2 demerit in the same term. Parents will need to come to school for a meeting. Repeat offenders will face a disciplinary hearing.

LEVEL 3 OFFENCES:	
 Bringing a dangerous weapon to school (without prior consent from the school) including any item that could compromise the health and safety of any others on the campus including fireworks and explosives. Viewing, possession, distribution of pornographic material Violent behaviour Substance abuse on the property or arriving at school under the influence of an unlawful substance Any form of smoking, including electronic cigarettes or similar products. (All schools are by law smoke-free zones.) Threatening a member of staff Theft Hate speech in any form or inciting racial tension Cheating in a test/exam Repeated plagiarism Truancy / Bunking class Any sexual activity on the school site Sexual harassment Any offence deemed criminal under the law 	SANCTION:Automatic disciplinary hearing.

Repeated Level 3 Offences will be dealt with under Common Law. A sanction will be imposed with a given time period for rehabilitation and improvement. If this is repeatedly ignored, students could face partial or even permanent exclusion.

****Bullying**: Any bullying offence will be dealt with under the Bullying policy.
