
In our relatively short history, we have achieved remarkable successes as a result of our flexible approach to meeting students' needs.





Registration Fee						
This is payable with the submission of an application form for a place in the School. It is non-refundable and covers the cost of administration of the application.	R750					
Placement Fee						
Nursery – Year 10: This secures a place at the International School of Cape Town against other potential applicants on the waiting list and is payable on confirmation of a place from the School. At the time of payment, the student's name is added to the School Roll. This placement fee is non-refundable.	R9 000

- For security reasons, we will not accept the payment of school fees in cash.

 The school does not have credit card facilities.
- Option 1 Upfront annual fee payments: Discounted Annual Fees paid before 14th January 2022.
- Option 2 Standard Annual Fees paid after 14th January 2022.
- Option 3 Quarterly fee payments: Parents who choose to pay their fees quarterly are required to pay these on the **first day of each term**.
- Option 4 Monthly fee payments Nursery to Year 11:


 Parents may prearrange with the School to pay their tuition fees over a 10 month period, each payment falling due on the first day of each month, January to October. Please note that the monthly option is only available to parents

enrolled at the school at the beginning of the academic year.

Option 5 Monthly fee payments – Year 12: School fees payable over a 9 month period, each payment falling due on the first day of each month, January to September.

Debit orders for Options 4 and 5: Please complete a <u>debit order form</u> should you wish to pay monthly. The school will also accept termly debit orders, as long as the terms thereof are confirmed with the accounts office before implementation.





Included in the fees

Tuition Fees are inclusive of all textbooks and exercise books which support the curriculum. Parents are responsible for the purchase of stationery.

A once-off Text Book Levy of R1 250 will be charged to all students entering Year 7, and all new students through to A Level (Year 13). Textbooks must be returned to the school at the end of each academic year. Any lost or damaged books will be invoiced to the student's school fee account.

Aftercare is available at the school at the rate of **R50 per hour**, or part thereof. **For late collection** there is a charge of **R110 per hour or part thereof**.

A morning bus service runs from Hout Bay & Tokai at a cost of R1 995per term.

Parents are responsible for the cost of all external examination fees.

Additional obligatory incidental fees

Other costs that you may incur include: camps and pupil insurance (R48 per annum).
