



Stationery requirements for High School 2023: Yr 10 - 13

The school will provide exercise books, hardcover manuscript books at the start of the school year.

You will need to have the following on the first day of school:

- Scientific calculator for Year 9 and above
- Mathematical instrument set
- Pencil bag or case and the following basics:

30cm ruler	Highlighter
Black or blue ballpoint pens	Pencil
Black fineliner	Eraser
Pencil	Sharpener

- You will also need a selection of files as stipulated below:
 - Select the correct Year Group column in the table.
 - Only buy the stationery specific to your child’s subject choices.

The school also provides one exam pad for each subject which requires these in Key Stages 4 and 5. Additional exam pads will be provided by parents.

Textbooks are supplied by the School. The books are numbered and are issued to you by your subject teacher. You need to sign for the books as a record. At the end of the year, the books are taken in again, so you need to return the book with the number you signed for. If you lose a book during the year or if it is damaged (more than normal ‘wear and tear’), you will be charged the replacement cost. Textbooks are usually very expensive, so look after them carefully.
