

Stationery requirements for High School 2024: Key Stage 3

The school will provide exercise books (feint/margin, quad and graph) and hardcover manuscript books at the beginning of the school year.

Bring the following on the first day of school:

- Calculator (preferably Casio fx-82ZA PLUS as this is the calculator supported during Mathematics lessons from Year 8 onwards.) A pocket calculator will suffice for Year 7.
- Mathematical instrument set
- Pencil bag or case
- Basic stationery:

1 x 30cm ruler (normal width) Black or blue ballpoint pens

Black fine liner HB Pencils
Pencil sharpener Highlighters
Eraser Scissors

Glue stick Pencil crayons (12pc)

Felt tipped pens (set of 10, medium point)

You will also need to buy a selection of files as stipulated below:

The textbooks are then returned at the end of the year. If a textbook is lost during the year or if it is damaged (more than normal 'wear and tear'), you will be charged the replacement cost. Please ensure that the textbooks are looked after.
