*In Years 4 to 6, children are supplied with an iPad to use at school for educational purposes. The iPads are stored and charged in the classrooms.*

- *Each child must provide a set of name-labelled, basic headphones (with a standard jack). We recommend wired 'over the head' headphones - please don't send in expensive headphones with additional features, or headphones that require charging.*
- Standard **recorder** (for Music lessons) - available from Music shops such as Paul Bothner.
- KS2 students should have an Oxford SA School Dictionary. *If you already have this from a previous year group, please send this back to school for the new school year.*
