We are pleased to report on the 2025 A Level, AS Level and IGCSE examination results which were released on 9th and 15th of January 2025.

Context:

- ISCT's A level cohort of 2025 numbered **20 registered students**.
- **Outcomes improved substantially in 2025 compared with 2024**. The proportion of top grades (A*-A) rose sharply from 5% to 53%, while A*-B outcomes more than doubled from 40% to 81%. In both years, the school sustained a *100% A-E pass rate**, with 2025 combining this consistency with a markedly stronger top-end profile, with no underperforming areas.
- **STEM subjects are a clear strength**, combining high entry numbers with strong top-grade attainment.
- **Stable results despite a small cohort**, reducing the impact of cohort volatility.
- **Positive outcomes regardless of class size**, including excellent results in small-entry subjects.
- **Broad curriculum success**, with strong performance across STEM, humanities, and creative subjects.

- One student completed the **CIPQ (Cambridge Research Project)** and was awarded an A grade. This marks the first time ISCT has supported, mentored, and entered a student for the CIPQ qualification.
- One student in Year 12 entered the **full A Level program** in 2 subjects and obtained A* grades for both.

Context:

- Strong overall attainment across the cohort, with **93% of all grades at A–D***, demonstrating that the large majority of students achieved secure outcomes.
- Over half of all results at higher grades, **with 51% of grades at A–B***, indicating solid top- and upper-middle performance across subjects.
- **30% of all grades achieved at A level**, reflecting a strong proportion of high academic attainment within the cohort.
- While the proportion of A*–B grades was lower than in 2024, **overall attainment strengthened in 2025**, with an improved A*–D pass rate and secure outcomes across the cohort.
- Resilience across a large and diverse entry, with **138 subject entries**, showing that outcomes remained stable and positive despite scale and subject demand.
- **Broadly secure lower-end performance**, with relatively few U grades recorded, supporting the view that students across the ability range were able to access success.
